DEPARTMENTAL NOTES: ACCOUNTING

1. Minimum competence (grade of C- or better) is required in all courses used in the major program.
2. Majors in the School of Business must complete 60 hours outside the School of Business (i.e., outside Acct, Econ, and Mgmt).
3. To avoid later registration difficulties, students are encouraged to take Humn 220 and 221 during their sophomore year.
4. Majors must complete the department writing requirement – see College Bulletin for information concerning the proficiency exam.
5. Enrollment in 300-level School of Business courses is restricted to junior and senior majors and minors in School of Business programs.
6. A minimum of 50% of all required Mgmt, Econ, or Acct courses, including a minimum of 9 credit hours of 300-level Mgmt classes, must be taken at Geneseo. Accounting majors must complete a minimum of 12 credit hours in Acct at Geneseo, including a minimum of 9 credit hours of 300-level Acct classes.
7. Majors must complete the department Professional Development Requirement- see College Bulletin for details.
