## DEPARTMENTAL NOTES: BLACK STUDIES

1. Courses are selected under advisement.
2. Recommended: Intermediate level (202) proficiency in a language, other than English, spoken widely in Africa.
3. Three patterns of electives are available; choose at least one:
  - a. Under advisement, a student may attend a black studies oriented college or university as a visiting student.
  - b. Study abroad in an approved, accredited program.
  - c. Register in a directed study in Black Studies at Geneseo for 3-9 credit hours, and/or enroll in an interdepartmental seminar in Black Studies for 3 hours.
4. Certification in secondary education (7-12) in Social Studies may be planned. See the School of Education for information.
5. To avoid later registration difficulties, students are encouraged to take Humn 220 and 221 during the sophomore year.
6. The English courses must be in literature.
7. Majors must fulfill the program writing requirement. Please see the program coordinator for details.
8. Majors must complete **69 hours** outside the major department.
