- 1. Minimum competence (grade of C- or better) is required in Gsci 160, 161, 170, 210, 220, 341, 343, 391, 392 and Phys 123/114, 125/116, 223, 224, 226, 228, 335, 362.
- 2. The natural science general education requirement of students graduating in Geophysics is satisfied by two semesters of chemistry.
- 3. Elective courses in Geological Sciences and Physics will be selected by consultation between the individual students and their academic advisors.
- 4. A student may elect a maximum of two additional hours in Natural Sciences and Mathematics for a total of 75. At least 69 of the required 120 semester hours must be taken outside the Geology department.
- 5. Majors must fulfill the Geological Sciences department writing requirement see College Bulletin.
