DEPARTMENTAL NOTES: SOCIOLOGY

- 1. The department recommends that majors complete Socl 211- Social Statistics prior to Socl 212 Sociological Research and that these courses be completed during the sophomore year. Socl 265 and 365, the theory courses, should be completed in the junior year. See the Undergraduate Bulletin for information concerning statistics courses taken through other departments.
- 2. No more than three credits of directed study and internships may be included among the 18 hours of electives in Sociology.
- 3. Minimum Competence Requirement Sociology majors are required to earn a minimum of a Cin each of the following courses SOCL 100, 211, 212, 265, 365, and the course used to fulfill the senior seminar requirement (SOCL 376, 377, 378, or 379). If a C- is not earned in these classes (100, 211, 212, 265, 365, and senior seminar), students may ONLY repeat a class once to achieve the required minimum grade.
- 4. Six electives in Sociology must be chosen. At least six hours must be at the 300-level. Students are encouraged to take classes across a broad range of topics in consultation with their advisors.
- 5. Electives in psychology are **recommended**. A maximum of 51 semester hours in Sociology may be included within the required 120. At least 69 hours of the required 120 must be taken outside of the major department.
- 6. To avoid later registration difficulties students are encouraged to take Humn 220 and 221 during the sophomore year.
- 7. Majors must fulfill the department writing requirement see College Bulletin.
